Timetable of Los Angeles Division of the Southern Pacific issued July 26, 1875, one year before the first railroad connection was made between Los Angeles and San Francisco. Trains were then operating from Los Angeles to Wilmington, Anaheim, Colton and San Fernando. Connection was made at the latter station with stage coaches for the ride over Tehachapi mountains to Caliente where passengers again took the train, reaching San Francisco after a rail and stage journey of 33 hours.
