Lemon Cove Association Names Officers for Year

Lemon Cove Association at Lemon Cove shipped 464 cars of citrus during the past season, reported Manager J. A. Moffett at the annual meeting held on Sept. 14. Navel and miscellaneous varieties totaled 215 cars; valencias, 75 cars; lemons, 136 cars; and grapefruit, 8 cars. Officers and directors named for the coming year are: President, F. L. Atwood; vice

president, Melvin Schlitz; secretary-manager and treasurer, J. A. Moffett; other directors, W. J. Evans, R. B. Montgomery, J. L. Smith, and Jay Kennedy Tod. Charles Bachman is assistant secretary. J. M. Griffin, manager of the Central California Citrus Exchange, discussed the citrus outlook for the coming season. The jaboticaba tree, a native of Brazil which the U. S. department of agriculture believes is a promising

new fruit tree for Florida, passed a severe cold-resistance test last winter. Fruits of the jaboticaba (pronounced zha-bo-ti-ca-ba) look and taste somewhat like muscadine grapes. Most of the fruits mature in early summer when fresh fruits are relatively scarce in the south. The tree is unique in bearing its grapelike fruits along the trunk and branches as well as on the twigs. A large jaboticaba tree, imported from Brazil 30 years ago, is now growing near Winter Haven.

The owner reports that although the cold weather last winter killed the blooms on the tree, it soon put out new growth, and he expects a crop of fruit this year. Two new-style containers for limes are now being used by the Florida Avocado and Persian Lime Growers, a cooperative in Florida. One is an individual sales box holding five limes with a trap window in top,
